## Schengen Application – Document Checklist

The checklist below is for you to use as a guide for your application. Some countries will require additional documentation to support your application. To ensure you have the correct documents you should visit the embassy webpages by using the links on UniLife:

Completed <b>application form</b> x 1 – available either online or to download and	
print via the embassy website	
One completed <b>supplementary form</b> – some embassies ask for a	
Supplementary information form to be completed.	
2 x passport photo: check the Embassy website for specifications, some will	
only request 1 photo.	
Schengen letter. – Available from the advice Zone	
<b>Health insurance</b> to the value of at least 30,000 EU. Insurance is available	
from the Post Office, large supermarkets or various providers online The	
insurance company will provide you with a letter or certificate to include	
with your application	
<b>Proof of travel plans</b> this will be the flight / ferry / train booking for your	
trip. This country insists that you must pre-book your travel before	
application	
<b>Proof of accommodation</b> this will be the booking for the hotel or other	
accommodation you will be staying at. It is easy to find hotels that make	
bookings either with a small deposit or no fee at all, so book with one of	
these.	
<b>Letter of invitation</b> . If you are visiting friends or family, they will need to	
write you a letter inviting you to come and visit. This should either be in	
English or in the language of the country you are visiting. If they are	
providing you with food and / or accommodation, the letter should state this as well.

<b>Schengen visa fee</b> . This varies from country to country so check the embassy	
website for charges and method of payment	
<b>Self-addressed special delivery envelope</b> . This is so that the Embassy can	
post your passport and / or documents back to you when a decision has	
been made and is available from all post offices.	
Copies of all documents provided. Generally, you will be expected to take	· · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · · ·
both originals and copies of all your documents to your appointment with	
you.
