\*For a **distinction** overall a student would need an average of B12 or 63% in part 1 plus a minimum of A14 or 70% in part 2: the dissertation. For a **merit** overall a Masters student would need to achieve an average of B11 or 60% in the part 1 plus a minimum of B12 or 63% for part 2: the dissertation

\*\*it is possible to distinguish between a mark of 0% for submitted work and a non-submission although both are recorded as 0 F2. The module result status would be 'normal' for a mark of zero as opposed to a non-submission.
